Time limits for erasure of the different categories of data	<p>They shall be kept for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected and to determine any possible liabilities that may arise from this purpose and from the processing of the data; financial data shall be kept for six years, in accordance with the Royal Decree of 22 August 1885, whereby the Commercial Code is published, in addition to the periods established in the internal regulations on archives and documentation.</p> <p>In processing operations to which Law 10/2010, of 28 April, on the prevention of money laundering is applicable, is applicable, a retention period of ten years is established.</p> <p>In processing operations whose legal basis is consent, the data will be kept until the consent is revoked or a right of deletion or opposition is exercised.</p>
