These working groups are promoted by the Ministerio de Ciencia e Innovación and will serve to interconnect the different Spanish agents participating as expert staff in committees and discussion forums on European programs and policies in the field of Research and Innovation.• The National Contact Points belonging to the signatory parties will also share information received both from the working groups mentioned in the previous paragraph and from the participants themselves in European Programs.
