Scientific evidence is gathered following a standardized and transparent process and will be available in a simple language and open to the public.</li> <li>• Both parties will perform any activity necessary to carry out the activities with a sole objective, the implementation of the activities. This singleness of purpose comprises all personal data processing operations since none of the signatory parties of this agreement can determine on its own the purpose of processing or move away from the ones previously mentioned. Likewise, all processing operations shall be implemented in a coordinated manner by the parties. Therefore, the means of the processing of personal data shall not be unilaterally set by any of the parties.</li> </ul>
